

“FAP-Now” Program Overview

Where and under what circumstances will FAP-DRN aid be dispatched?

- Large natural disasters in any 3rd World country which is not a ‘conflict area’ in which large numbers of people have been affected.

When will the shipments begin?:

- The FAP-DRN financial sponsors must number at least 1000 before a DRN shipment will be considered.
- A FAP-registered Family Missionary Center must be in the vicinity of the disaster and have completed the required preparatory plans. Those plans consist of registering with FAP and making prior contact with bulk-distributors of specific relief supplies that will be tailored for the kind of disaster occurring. In other words, supplies needed for an earthquake are different than those needed for floods, etc.

What are the order of events that will transpire when disaster strikes?:

- FAP N.A. office will communicate with the foreign Missionary center regarding the disaster situation and confirming present field conditions. On the contrary, if a major disaster strikes, registered mission centers may contact FAPs office regarding the situation.
- A flash Email is sent out to Disaster Response Network sponsors and calls are made to inform of situation and request financial assistance.
- Depending on network response:
 - If less than \$10,000 is received - Donated funds will be sent to Family Missions field team for DR use. Report and pictures must be returned to FAP for final report to donor network within 3 weeks.
 - \$10,000 to \$20,000 – FAP Staff Coordinator will depart within 48 hrs. to assist field missionaries in DR until purchasing of materials, transport and delivery are completed. Report and pictures will be brought back for final report for donor network when project is completed.
 - \$20,000 to \$30,000 - FAP DR team of trained staff will leave within 48 hrs to assist local field missionaries and volunteers in relief effort until initial response is completed.
 - \$30,000 or more – Same as above except that a portable water purification system and other specialized, disaster response equipment may be included.
- When delivery of material is completed or reconstruction phase begins, FAP staff coordinator and team return and a delivery report and pictures must be sent off to donors within 1 week.
- Any late arriving funds will be used for outstanding disaster response expenses or kept until next disaster.
